Applicants submit:

- Curriculum vitae
- 1000-word essay on "Haemostasis for acute aortic dissection surgery", or "Haemorrhage control in major thoracic trauma"
- 4 minute video outlining how you perform an emergency room thoracotomy for a penetrating cardiac injury (stab)
- The **essay** should include commentary on technique, blood products, haemostatic agents and what to do in cases of extreme coagulopathy (to name a few!).
- In the video you must demonstrate the incision graphically on a model/skeleton/artificial person.
- The educational grant is aimed at facilitating recipients' attendance at a Cardiac or Thoracic conference/hospital unit/ clinical centre.
- Categories will be either in the sub-specialties of Cardiac OR Thoracic. One position will be allocated to a New Zealand recipient (either Cardiac or Thoracic).

The successful grant recipients will be recognized at the conference dinner of the ANZSCTS Annual Scientific Meeting in Wellington, New Zealand.
